Selection Criteria Ekurhuleni Chess

Why a Selection criteria ?

- 1) To ensure fairness and transparency with the selection of teams
- 2) To motivate chess players to strive for excellence
- 3) To obtain optimal choice of provincial teams

How does a player get selected ?

- 1) Be a paid up affiliated member of Ekurhuleni chess
- 2) Be a member of one of the clubs affiliated to Ekurhuleni chess
- 3) Play 7 tournaments with a minimum of 4 internal tournaments
- 4) Play minimum of 2 of the 3 trials
- 5) Should a player not have enough games to qualify the Exco will investigate the merits of the case and make a decision based on their investigation.

Chess players will be ranked by using the average of their five best performance ratings of registered tournaments between 1 October and 31 July. The data as published by Chessa will be used. This will determine which teams players represent at Nationals.

Board orders will be determined by the average of the five best performance ratings (personal performance rating measured against the tournament performance rating) For the period 1 October until 30 September (12 months)

The Exco will meet to consult regarding the board orders and determine final board orders. In the case of a dispute the president will have the right to make the final decision.

Board orders will be announced at the year end function.

Letters for schools to confirm selection will only be issued once the deposit for Nationals have been paid into the Ekurhuleni chess account

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
